ReStore home improvement outlets are open to the public and offer quality home furnishings, building supplies, appliances, and more at discounted prices. All revenue supports Twin Cities Habitat for Humanity's work to create, expand, and promote affordable housing opportunities and advance racial equity in housing. Twin Cities Habitat's first ReStore opened in New Brighton in 2007, and the Minneapolis ReStore opened in 2016. Support for ReStore has grown, and we recognized a need for a third location in the northwest metro. The new 27,000 sq. ft. store in Brooklyn Park will provide a place to donate, shop and volunteer to support Twin Cities Habitat.
